Acceptable documents for proof of residency

In order to apply for the role of a wholetime firefighter you must permanently reside within 20 miles of the boundary of the county of Cambridgeshire as determined by Cambridgeshire Fire and Rescue Service's mapping system.

You will be required to provide evidence from the list below to prove this:

- Full and current UK, EC or EEA driving licence (your driving licence must have your correct address listed on it)

Plus at least one of the following:

- Bank Statement (issued within the last 3 months)
- Council Tax Bill (issued within the last 12 months)
- Utility Bill e.g. gas, water etc (issued within the last 3 months)
- Building Society Statement (issued within the last 3 months)
- Credit/Store Card Statement (issued within the last 3 months)
- Mortgage Statement (issued within the last 12 months)
- Financial Statement e.g. pension, endowment or ISA (issued within the last 12 months)
- Addressed payslip (issued within the last 3 months)
- Addressed P45 or P60 Statement (issued within the last 12 months)
- Valid TV Licence (issued within the last 12 months)
- Valid Insurance Certificate (issued within the last 12 months)
